TEMPLATED POSTS FOR LINKEDIN TO GET YOU STARTED

- My favourite thing about running my own business is _____. What's yours?
- My ideal client is _____. What's yours?

Things to consider:

- Add images where you can.
- Try and ask open-ended questions
- Speak to your target audience - what are their struggles? How can you tie those into your experiences?
- People buy from people, so don't be afraid to be honest and authentic.
- Re-use content; people won't remember what you have posted before, so definitely use it again if it gets a lot of engagement.
- Utilising hashtags can help you get your content in front of relevant eyes - but just use a few.
- Sharing relevant news articles with an opinion is another great way to become a 'thought leader' in your space.
- Make sure you're engaging with comments on your posts to further boost their reach
- Always look for other conversations to join in as well! (You never know, it may give you inspiration for another post!)
